

TYBC SUMMER INTENSIVE 2018

Welcome to the TYBC Summer Intensive for 2018. We hope our summer dancers will benefit from the thorough training available at TYBC, but also enjoy themselves and make new friends. To insure that the Summer Intensives run smoothly, please read the following information.

All parents of students signing up for the Summer Intensive must read and sign a liability form, either during the online registration process, or in person at the desk.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION, DRESS CODE AND REGULATIONS

ROOM AND BOARD:

Room and Board for the Intensive is provided for students through host families at the rate of \$250 per week. There are also several reasonably-priced hotels in the area, and food is readily available near the studio. Our host families provide transportation to and from the studio.

TUITION ASSISTANCE:

Male dancer discount of 50%.

Limited assistance available for need-based scholarships. You will be required to provide documentation of income.

PLACEMENT CLASS:

Placement class will occur on the Sunday before the intensive begins. All students in the Intermediate (Gold and up) to Advanced levels need to be at the placement class. Each student will receive a number level within the broader definitive categories so that we can tailor the classes to meet the needs of our students. **Summer intensive II will not have a placement class.**

CONDUCT CODE:

Students are expected to behave in a courteous and respectful way, at all times, toward the teachers and their fellow students. No bullying, or mean-spirited behavior is tolerated at TYBC. Behavioral issues are handled on a three strike basis. First, through discussing the problem with the student. Then, through a parent/student/director conference. Last, with dismissal from the program. The director reserves the right to remove problem students from the program without refund.

We have the following rules for dancers:

No Gum inside the building.

No Eating in the dressing room.

Water bottles are allowed in the classroom, but must be placed against the wall near the audio equipment. Water breaks will be at the discretion of the instructor. If your child has excessive water needs because of medical issues, please let us know.

DRESS CODE:

Girls: Any solid-color leotard (no shiny material, no neon colors, no midribs or side cut outs), pink tights and ballet shoes, pointe shoes (for those who have them), jazz shoes (any color), character shoes (if you have them), black character skirt or other A-line or circle skirt (calf to knee-length).

Intermediate and advanced students may wear skirts only in variation class and rehearsal. No baggy shorts, leg warmers, boots or sweaters in ballet class. These may be worn with t-shirts, etc. in modern, tap, or jazz class.

Boys: Solid white or solid colored t-shirt, or the black TYBC boy's shirt (available at the school), black tights/black shoes, dance belt undergarment.
